SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I. HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major rivers are flowing below low Flood level.

II. METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

Yesterday's shallow trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of the country today lies over Kashmir and adjoining areas.

III. WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Mainly dry weather is expected over most parts of the country. However isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.
