
FLOOD ALERT (5TH TO 7TH SEPTEMBER, 2014)

According to latest meteorological conditions a Well Marked Monsoon Low lies over Rajasthan (India) which is likely to affect upper Catchments of all the major Rivers except Indus

Under this Scenario Very High to Exceptionally High Flood Level is expected in the Rivers Chenab & its associated Nullahs, where as High Flood Level is expected in River Ravi along with its associated Nullahs.

High to Very High Flood Level is also expected in Rivers Jhelum & Sutlej.

SIGNIFICANT FLOOD FORECAST FOR RIVER CHENAB


River Chenab at Marala is likely to attain High to Very High flood level ranging between 350,000 cusecs to 450,000 cusecs during 1400 PST of 04-09-2014 to 1000 PST of 05-09-2014.

River Chenab at Khanki is likely to attain High to Very High flood level ranging between 350,000 cusecs to 450,000 cusecs during 0200 PST of 05-09-2014 to 2200 PST of 05-09-2014.

River Chenab at Qadirabad is also likely to attain High to Very High flood level ranging between 350,000 cusecs to 450,000 cusecs during 0800 PST of 05-09-2014 to 0400 PST of 06-09-2014
