



Pakistan's Monsoon (JAS) 2017 Rainfall update

22nd September, 2017

Highlights:

- During the period 1st July to 22nd September (at 0800 PST) 2017, rainfall over the country as whole has been **below** to its normal value **(-21%)** (Fig-1). On regional scale, over all regions, the rainfall during the season has been observed **below** to its normal (Fig-2).
- During past 22 days in September 2017, on regional scale, rainfall has been observed **normal/below normal** over almost all regions except Punjab & GB where were **above** to normal.
- In the month of August, the rainfall over country was below normal **(-28%)**. On regional scale, rainfall was observed **below** normal over almost all regions except GB & KPK where was **close** to normal.
- In the month of July, country as a whole, the rainfall was below normal **(-20%)**. On regional scale, rainfall was observed **below** normal over almost all regions except Sindh where was **close** to normal.

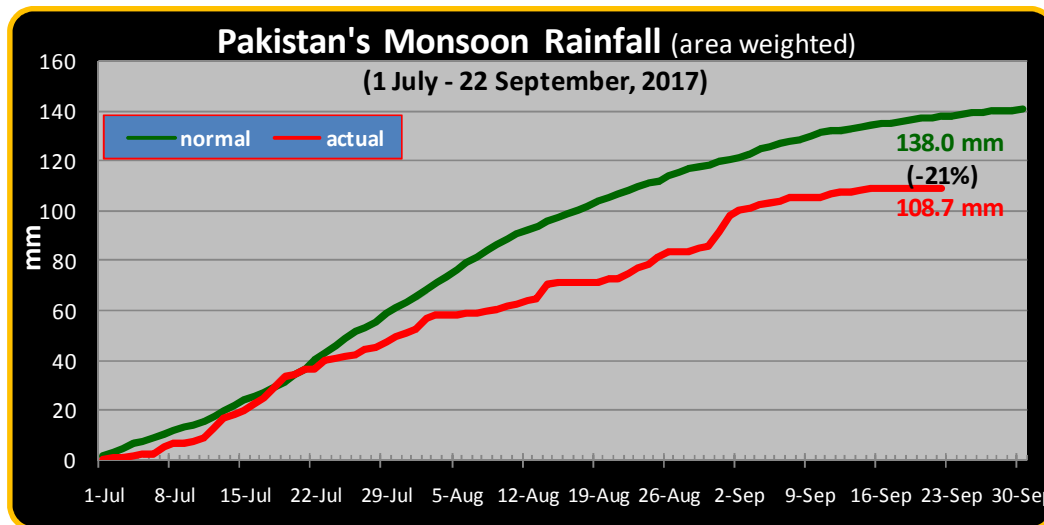


Fig-1: Country cumulative daily actual & normal rainfall

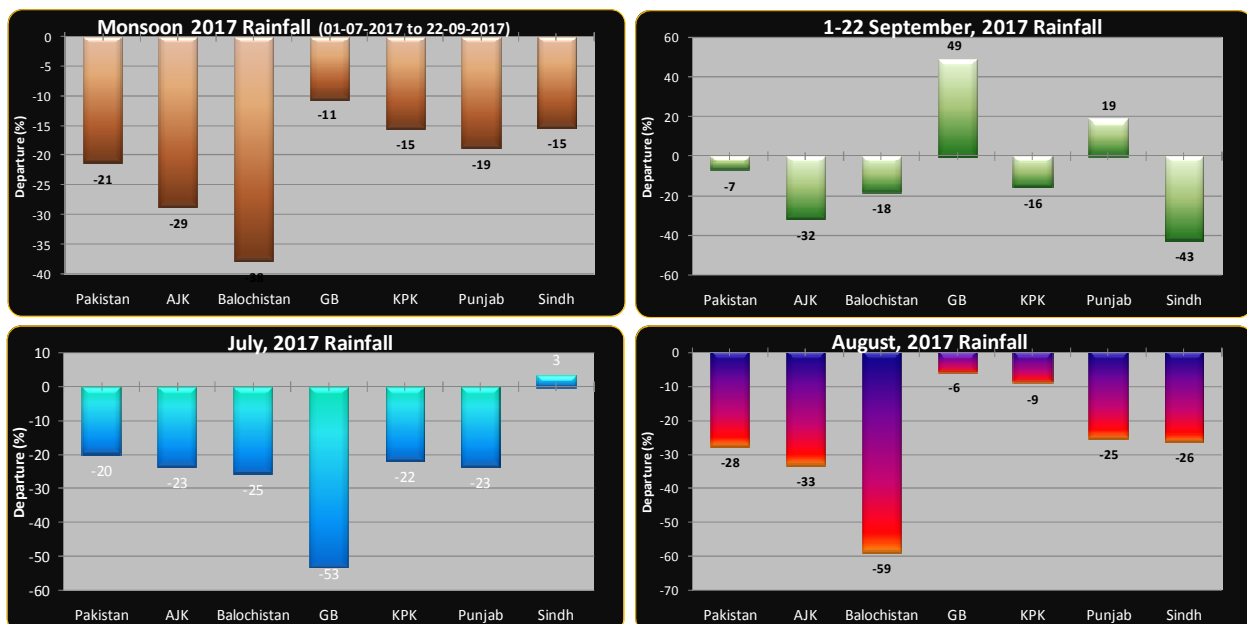


Fig-2: Country's seasonal & monthly rainfall
