- 4. Any employee intends to pursue higher studies inconsistent with the above subjects, then his application may be forwarded to this office with proper justification and recommendation by the supervisory office concerned that how his studies will be beneficial for the department.
- 5 This delegation of powers may be exercised with immediate effect. Therefore, the cases with ex-post facto permissions, where official timings may be compromised or of BS-17.

and above may be sent to this office which will be decided on case to case basis. In addition, D.G. Met. S may refuse any NOC on administrative ground even in the relevant field.
