

$\underline{Experimental\ Minimum\ Temperature}(T_{min})\ Forecast\ November\ 2013$

Output of the Combined General Circulation Model (CGCM) is used to predict the minimum temperature over the selected stations of Pakistan. The highlight of the November minimum temperature forecast is above normal (1981-2010) minimum temperature (T_{min}) in most parts of the country. Positive departure from normal is most prominent in central Punjab, southern Punjab along the adjoining Sindh and areas of coastal Balochistan. Whereas coastal belt of Sindh, areas of Balochistan bordering Afghanistan and Gilgat-Baltistan region are expected to remain slightly cooler than long term average temperature(1981-2010).





In the above figure stations are arranged according to the increasing latitude from left to right.
