A significant wet spell is likely to affect Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan from the evening of 26th June to 1st July 2025. During this period, scattered to widespread rain and thunderstorms, with isolated heavy falls, are expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, while rain and thunderstorms are likely at many places in Gilgit-Baltistan. The prevailing weather conditions, increase the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs), and flash floods events in vulnerable glaciated regions of Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

2. All concerned are advised to remain alert and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.
