The temperatures in Gilgit-Baltistan is expected to increase with the approaching summers. Resultantly the discharge from Shishper glacier has been increasing with the increasing temperatures. It is most likely that internal conduit system within the Shishper glacier may develop due to enhanced melting and the lake situation will become critical increasing the probability of triggering GLOF event in the coming days. Local communities and relevant organizations are advised to remain vigilant and observe precautionary measures.
